This event is an opportunity for the public to witness the vibrant research-creation being produced at Hexagram | CIAM.

This first edition of **HEXA\_OUT** will attempt to shed light on the concepts of efficiency and acceleration when researchers from the arts, humanities and engineering work collaboratively. The discussion will be moderated by astronomer **Roger Malina**, Distinguished Professor of Arts and Technology

and Professor of Physics at the University of Texas, Dallas. Since 1982 he has been the Executive Editor of Leonardo (MIT Press) whose mission is to promote and make visible work that explores the interaction between the arts, sciences and new technologies.

This event is the first of Hexagram | CIAM's 2012-13 public programming with a new partnership with PHI Center, which focuses on their complementary mandates, bringing academic research-creation and quality dissemination to the Montreal community.
